



LOGAN ELM HIGH SCHOOL PARKING REGISTRATION AND REGULATIONS

September, 2007

Driving to school is a privilege, which may be denied. Students with a valid driver's license and proof of liability insurance may drive to school and park in the student parking lot. Students who are issued parking permits accept the responsibility of adhering to school policies and safe driving practices. Authorized personnel who have reason to believe a search is necessary for the health, safety and protection of the students and the orderly conduct of the school may search any vehicle brought onto the school property.

Listed below are regulations for student parking:

1. A maximum speed limit of 10 miles per hour is to be followed at all times. Reckless or unsafe operation of any vehicle on school grounds will result in the loss of parking privileges.
2. Once students have parked their vehicle, **they should proceed immediately to the school.** The parking lot is not a hang out. Failure to do so could result in discipline and/or parking privileges revoked.
3. The school does not assume responsibility for loss or damage to the vehicles.
4. Student drivers must realize that driving to school and parking on school grounds is a privilege and not a right. Disciplinary action may occur if students do not properly follow parking policies established by the school. This may include revoking a student's parking permit. Parking privileges may also be denied for those students who violate attendance/tardy policies.
5. Parking permits are to be displayed on the rear view mirror of the vehicle at all times.
6. Students will be assigned a numbered parking spot and are expected to park in that spot daily. Each parking tag will also have a numbered parking spot on it. Failure to park in your assigned spot will result in discipline and/or parking privileges being revoked.
7. Students are **NOT TO PARK** in unnumbered spots.
8. **All past due fines and fees must be paid before a parking tag is issued.**
9. Replacement cost for a parking tag will be \$10.00 (1st time), \$20.00 (2nd time) and \$30.00 (3rd time). If the tag is lost again, the student may lose their driving privileges. Do not lose your tag!
10. **A copy of your driver's license and proof of liability insurance must be on file in the main office before a parking tag is issued.**
11. Students who have been assigned a tag, have parked in the school parking lot, are in the correct parking spot, but do not have the tag displayed on their rear view mirror, will be given a written warning, and will be assessed a \$5.00 fine (1st time), \$10.00 fine (2nd time) and \$15.00 (3rd time). Once the written warning is given to the student and the parent, and the student reaches a 4th violation without their tag properly displayed, their car may be towed at the owner's expense. **NO FURTHER WARNINGS WILL BE GIVEN.**
12. Students cannot switch their tag from one student's car (who is registered and on file) to another student's car that is not registered. The student (with the registered tag) will be assessed a \$10.00 fine and a written warning. **Any future occurrences may result in towing the car at the owner's expense.**
13. Students who fail to register their vehicle will receive a written warning and a \$5.00 fine (1st time), \$10.00 fine (2nd time), \$15.00 fine (3rd time). On the fourth occurrence, the student's car may be towed at the owner's expense. **NO FURTHER WARNING WILL BE GIVEN.**
14. **STUDENTS ARE NOT TO DRIVE BEHIND MCDOWELL AND/ OR BUS GARAGE. FINES WILL BE ASSESSED TO THOSE WHO DISOBEY.**
