

LOGAN ELM HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE

ACCREDITED BY THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE NORTH CENTRAL ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGES AND SCHOOLS

NAME – Logan Elm High School is named in honor of an American elm tree that was made famous when the Mingo Indian Chief, Logan, delivered a classic oration under its branches in 1774.

FACULTY – The staff is composed of 37 teachers, two counselors, two secretaries, two monitors, three custodians, a librarian, a library technician, an athletic director, an assistant principal and a principal. The average number of years teaching experience is 14.1. Fifty-seven percent have a Masters degree.

RATIO – The on-campus teacher-student ratio for 2004-2005 was 21.4 to one; the counselor-student ratio was 360 to one.

INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM - There are 15 departments offering 125 different courses over 240 teaching periods. Classes are arranged on a block schedule. The majority of classes meet for an 90 minute block per semester. The remainder employ the traditional 43 minute session for a semester or the year. A combined venture with the Pickaway-Ross Career & Technical Center provides 1 Tech Prep Program. Students attending the JVS may choose from 20 specialty areas.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS – Students must earn 24 credits to graduate. Subject area requirements include: four English, three Social Studies, three Math, three Science and one Health/Physical Education.

GRADING – To receive credits, five points must be earned in each class and the second semester must be passed.

LIBRARY – Our library contains 9,650 items of which 5,646 are nonfiction, 493 are biographical, 2,502 are fiction, 672 are reference and 337 are nonprint media. Attendance averaged over 256 per day. Total expenditures for 2003-2004 were \$16,436.75.

STUDENT DATA – The current student body consists of 753 students, of this group 72 attend the Pickaway-Ross Career & Technical Center.
