

Dear Parents/Guardians,

During the months of April and May we will conduct our End of Course Exams required for graduation. As you may recall students must earn 22 credits for graduation along with 18 points on their End of Course Exams. We are changing our format for delivering these exams from large group testing to small group testing this year. In order to make this possible we will operate on a two hour delay schedule on the following days in the chart listed below. Students who are not testing will follow the 2 hour delay bell schedule, however buses will still follow the regular bell schedule. If your child needs transportation they will need to ride the bus at their normal time and we will direct them to a study hall during the 2 hour delay testing window.

Students who are testing will be required to attend school at their normal time. Student testing will be divided into small groups of 20-25 and placed into classrooms in an effort to create a better test environment. Attendance on these scheduled testing days is crucial. Please make every effort possible to ensure your child is present on the day of testing.
